How Online Proctored (OP) Testing Works

The Online Proctored (OP) GED Test: A Brief History

- We launched the OP GED test in June 2020 as a direct result of the pandemic.
- In Spring/Summer of 2020, approximately 70% of GED test centers across the nation closed on a temporary basis due to state and local regulations.
- A handful of states had no test centers available.

GED Test Delivery Method
Across the U.S. over the past 12 months:

- 83% of testing at a test center
- 17% of testing done via OP
- Approx. 45,000 individuals took one or more GED tests via OP during the past 12 months.

Taking an OP GED Test: How it Works

- Students register and schedule their OP test via their ged.com account just like in-person testing.
- Requires a laptop or desktop computer (PC or Mac) with a camera, microphone, and stable internet connection.
Cannot be a Chromebook.
- Must be in an enclosed room with a door than can be shut, quiet environment, no other individuals in the room.
- Students must complete a system check at the time of their appointment, or prior to their appointment, to ensure their system will support delivery of an OP exam.

Online Proctored GED Test: Key Information

- Students must earn a score of 145 or higher on the GED Ready test within the past 60 days in any subject area they wish to take via OP. Only required before the 1st OP attempt in each subject area.
- Available in English and Spanish
- Test accommodations available to students with a diagnosed disability who want to test via OP.

What Students Have Told Us

In a survey students told us the top benefits of OP testing include:

- Convenience/availability of test appointment times
- No need to travel to test center
- Reduced anxiety/stress in testing from home

Online Proctored Testing: Benefits & Challenges

Benefits

- Appointments are available 24/7 during weekdays and weekend availability as well
- Test-takers can cancel or reschedule their appointment all the way up to their scheduled appointment time
- Test from the comfort of home or other location that meets the OP testing criteria
- Students have the ability to mix OP testing and in-person

Challenges

- Some students are going to encounter technical issues often related to their home internet connection or equipment.
- Some students are going to intentionally, or unintentionally, violate OP policies and have their testing session ended and, or, score(s) revoked.
- Students cannot use a hand-held calculator or physical scratch paper

OP Testing – The Big Concern



The big concern with OP testing is test security.



OP testing is not as secure as an individual going in-person to a test center

OP Test Security Concerns

What is Proxy Testing?

- When someone not the registered candidates takes an exam/test in-place of the candidate (remote access or in-person)

OP proxy services are technically sophisticated and often operate from outside the U.S.

OP proxy services are charging learners in the range of \$500-\$1,500 to take the OP GED test and GED Ready.



OP Security Challenges in More Depth

Security issues with OP testing are a major issue for all test providers who offer OP testing. This is an industry wide issue

“Businesses” are advertising services to help students cheat on OP exams.

Let’s call it an “arms race.” Proxy services identify weaknesses in our security and try to exploit them. We are constantly trying to enhance our security infrastructure to thwart them.

Social media is replete with advertisements from OP proxy services

Any student proven to have cheated on their GED test will be subject to any, or all, of these penalties: revocation of all GED test passing scores; revocation of their credential if earned; and a 12 month ban from GED testing.

OP Challenges

Security Challenges

- We have implemented new security measures to stop individuals we suspect may be using a proxy service.
- 5 states do not allow OP testing
- A handful of other states have moved toward what we call a restricted model, which requires the state to approve an individual to take an OP test.
- Other security measures are being considered.

Challenges

- OP test-takers behave at times in ways they would not at a test center.

Examples:

- Accessing prohibited items such as phones, earbuds, calculators, pen/paper
- Leaving the camera view during testing
- Refusing to follow protocol
- 3rd party entering room

Lastly, technical issues with test-takers internet or other hardware/software are common.

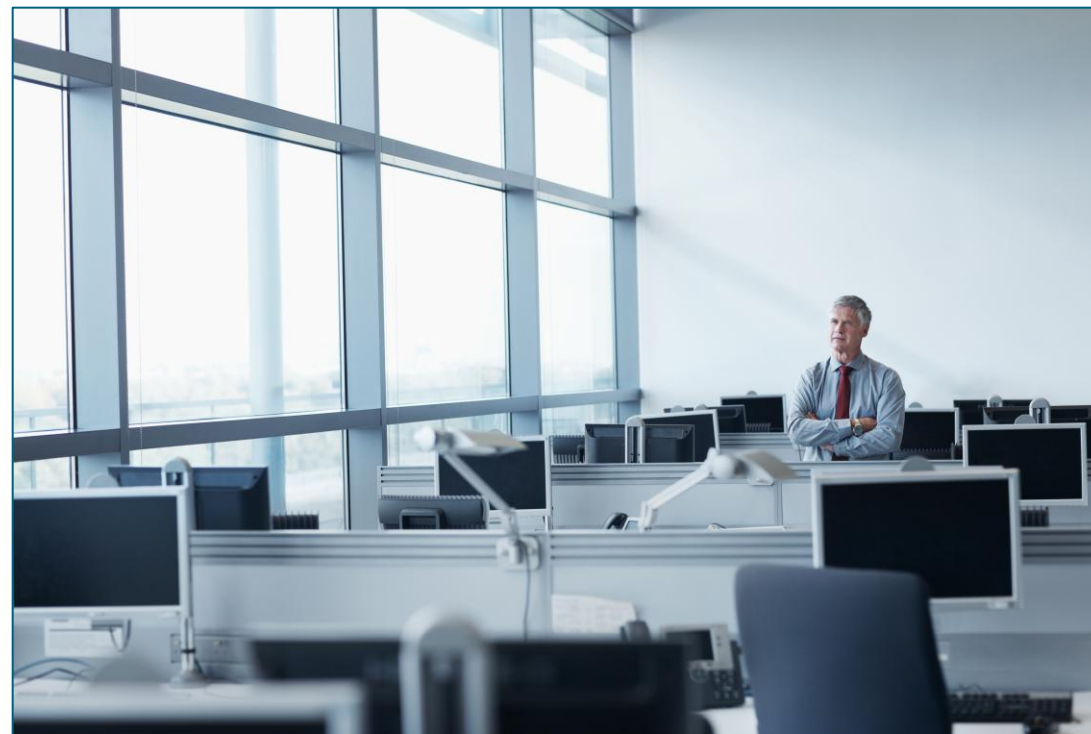

Bottom line, OP testing is likely never to be as secure as an individual going to a test center to take the GED test or any test.



Test Center vs OP & OP Test Tips

In-Person Testing:

- 3 attempts per subject area before 60 day wait period (varies by state)
- Standard GED price is \$36 per subject, but varies widely by state
- No GED Ready requirement before 1st GED test in most states
- Handheld calculator allowed, erasable noteboard provided
- 1 discounted retake per subject area

Online Proctored Testing:

- 2 attempts per subject area before a 60 day wait period
- Standard GED price is \$36 per subject, but varies widely by state
- GED Ready score of 145+ within 60 days is needed prior to first attempt
- Handheld calculator, erasable noteboard or pen/paper **not** allowed
- No discounted retakes

OP vs Test Center Policies

Online Proctored

- An OP GED test can be scheduled for the next day and beyond (same day scheduling as been eliminated)
- One subject per test appointment is allowed

Test Center

- An in-person GED test can be scheduled for the next day and beyond
- Individual can schedule one or more subjects in an appointment

OP Test-takers Under the Age of 18

A parent or guardian must be present during the check-in process in order to provide consent for the test-taker who is a minor.

Parent or guardian must present a government ID and provide verbal consent to the proctor.

Once this occurs the parent or guardian will exit the room.

Calculator, Scratch Pad & Virtual Whiteboard

- Only the on-screen calculator may be used with OP tests
 - Handheld calculators are not allowed for security reasons
 - The on-screen calculator is the same as in-person test and the GED Ready.
 - Calculator tutorial and practice available online to students & educators

- Virtual whiteboard & scratchpad available on OP tests
 - Students cannot use physical scratch paper or dry erase boards for security reasons
 - Students can practice with the virtual whiteboard and scratchpad online prior to testing

The 5 Things Every Educator Needs to Know to Help Students Take an O.P. Test

1. They can find all the info they need about this option at GED.com under “About the Test” or in their GED.com account
2. Before test day students should practice with the Whiteboard tool to get comfortable before they test
3. Complete the online system check before scheduling – to make sure their equipment works properly
4. Encourage student to check-in 15-30 minutes before their OP test appointment
5. The content on the O.P. test is the same type of questions they would see if they tested in person

Common Issues to Avoid

- Poor internet connection: *hotspots are not supported*
- Must have webcam: *No using cell phone cameras as substitute*
- Unauthorized materials – extra screens, paper, notebooks
- Another person in the room
- Tester left view of webcam

Common Questions

Q. Can the OP test work in a correctional setting? Unlikely

Q. Can our students take the OP test at our adult education center? Yes, but....

Q. Why can't I use a physical calculator or scratch paper? Test Security

Q. Can I take the OP test on a Chromebook? Unfortunately not

Q. Are accommodations available on the OP test? Yes they are

Online Proctored Test in the Correctional Setting

We've seen it work in a few select correctional facilities, but for the vast majority of correctional facilities OP is not going to work due to the OP requirements and rules within correctional facilities.

We will work with you to help your correctional facility get set-up as a GED testing center.

OP Test-takers must:

- Be online in order to take the OP test
- Be alone in a room
- Be on webcam/recorded
- Present a government issued ID

Can Students Take the OP Test at our Adult Education Center?

We do not recommend this and I would dissuade you from doing this.

It has worked, or is working, at some adult education centers although most adult education programs have their students go to a local test center since most test centers have reopened.

Please be aware of potential technical challenges. Review the OnVUE Technical Requirements.

- Frequent issue at adult ed centers – firewall/computer security software installed on the center's computers prevents the OP test from normal test delivery. This issue is common.

Common Questions

Q. What if my internet connection is lost for a few seconds while I'm taking the OP test. Can I resume once a connection is re-established? **Yes**

Q. Can I resize the text onscreen? **Yes**

Q. Can I wear my Apple watch during my OP test? **No**

Q. Is the OP test available in Spanish? **Yes, and there are Spanish speaking proctors**

Preparing Your Students for the OP Test

To-Do List for Test SUCCESS

- Watch the OP video
- View the computer tutorial (repeat as needed)
- Learn the basic tools of the test (highlighter, font/color change, text size, etc.)
- View the calculator tutorial (repeat as needed)
- Know where to find and how to use test resources (calculator, symbol tool, formula page, calculator reference)
- Learn to use the onscreen whiteboard (best for math equations)
- Learn to use the onscreen scratchpad (best for RLA notes)
- Repeat all of above as needed

Know the OP Rules

Online GED Exam Rules

- Cheating is strictly prohibited
- You consent to being videotaped and recorded
- You must be in a private, walled room with a closed door
- No one else is permitted in the room once your exam has started, for any reason
- You may not leave your work area for any reason
- You cannot use a calculator or scratch paper, take physical notes or talk
- Personal items, mobile phones, headphones and watches must be out of reach
- Food, smoking and gum are prohibited
- You cannot move your webcam once your testing session has started
- Mumbling, speaking out loud or covering your mouth will lead to a warning
- Headphones and headsets (wired or Bluetooth) are not allowed unless explicitly approved

Breaking any of these rules will result in your exam being revoked, loss of payment, and you will be banned from testing in the future.

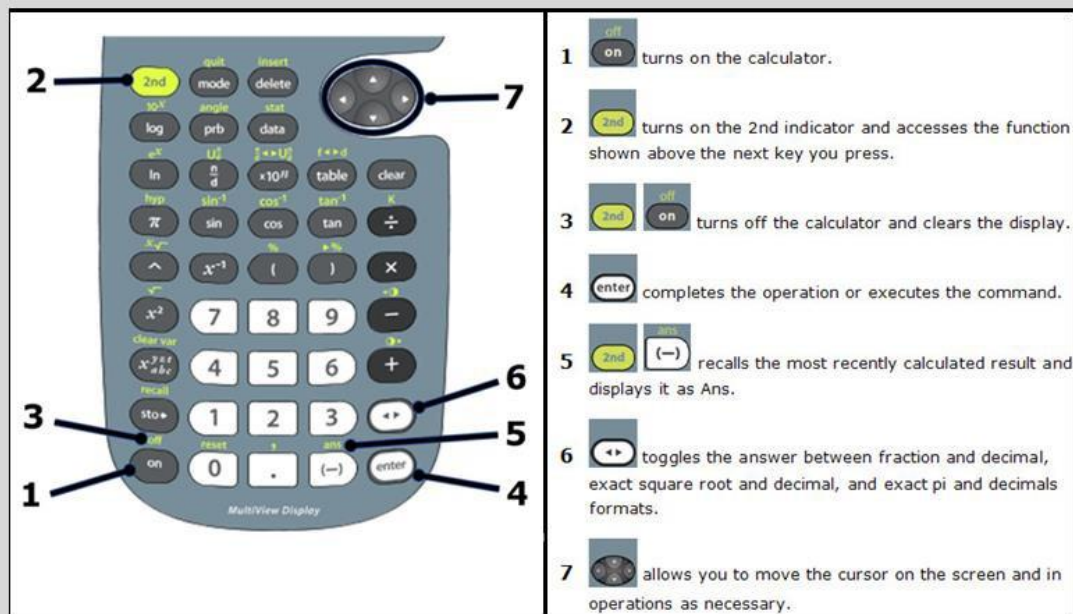

Basic Operations of the Calculator

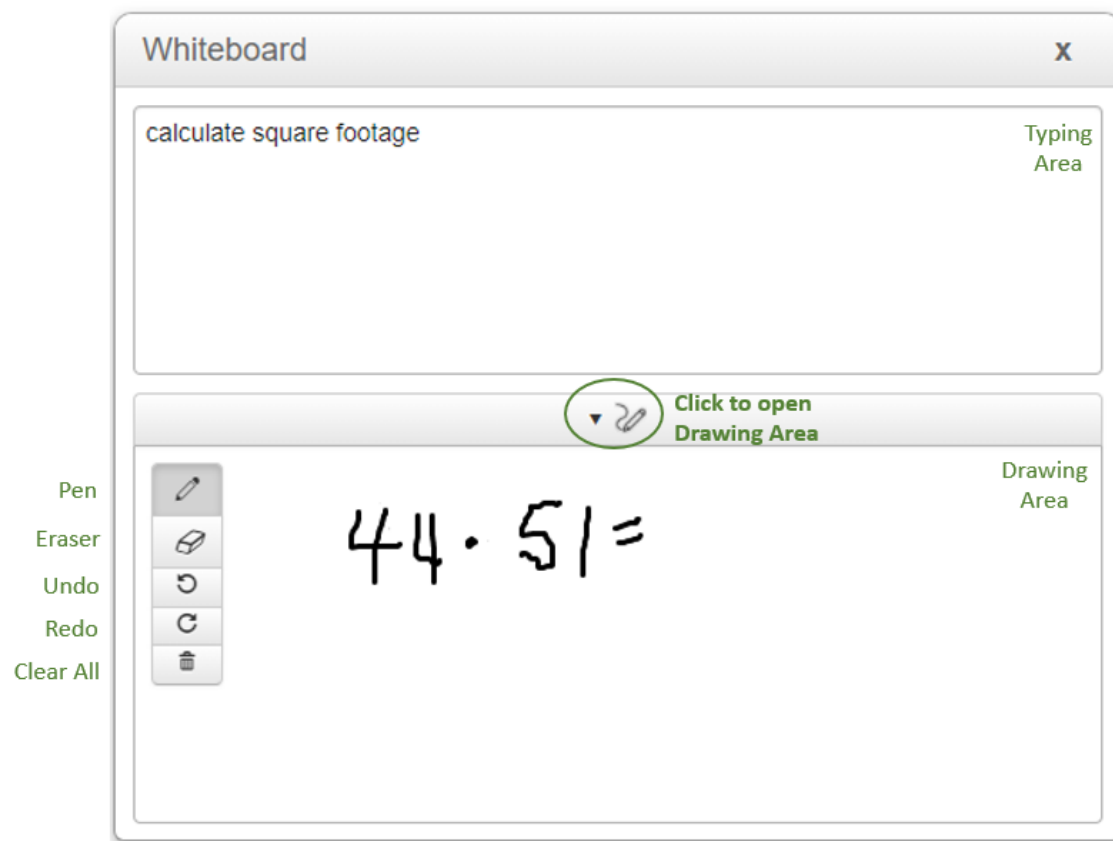
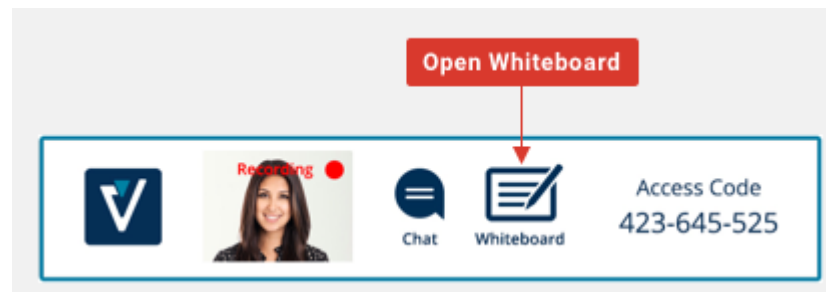
Locate the **basic keys** on the image and review their **functions** in the numbered list.



- 1 **on** turns on the calculator.
- 2 **2nd** turns on the 2nd indicator and accesses the function shown above the next key you press.
- 3 **off** turns off the calculator and clears the display.
- 4 **enter** completes the operation or executes the command.
- 5 **2nd** **ans** recalls the most recently calculated result and displays it as Ans.
- 6 **format** toggles the answer between fraction and decimal, exact square root and decimal, and exact pi and decimals formats.
- 7 **navigation pad** allows you to move the cursor on the screen and in operations as necessary.

- Use to take notes from reading passages

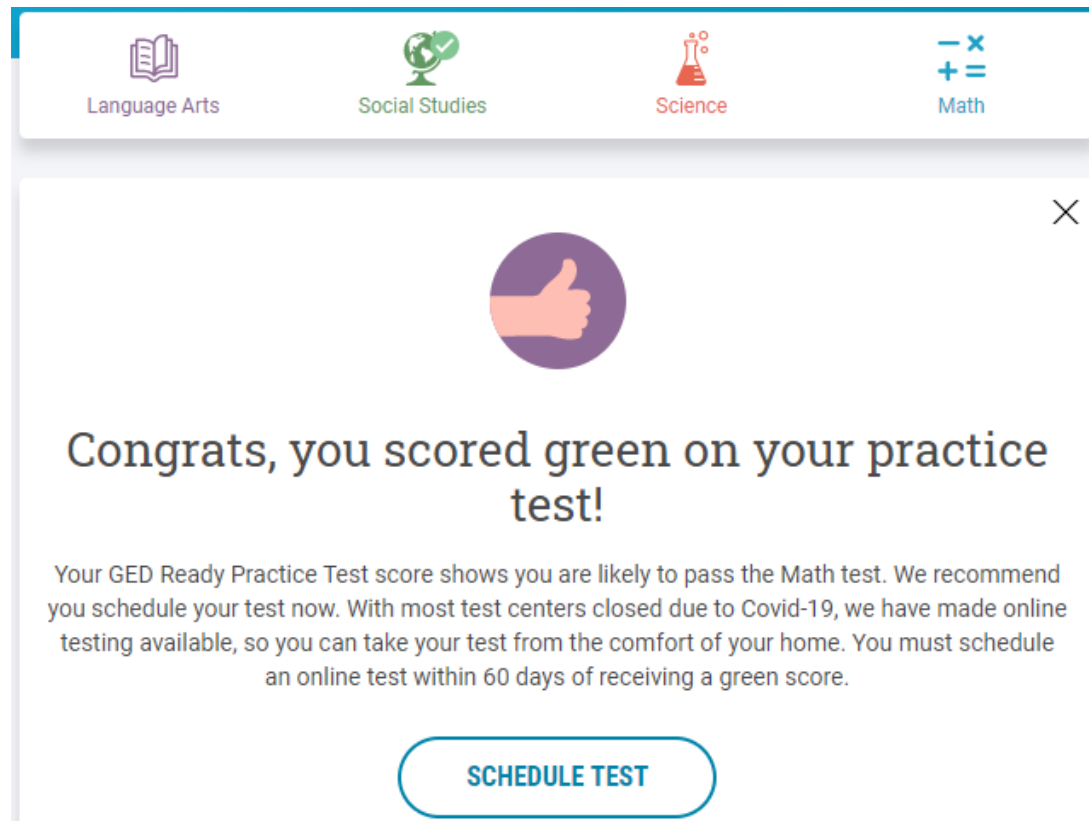

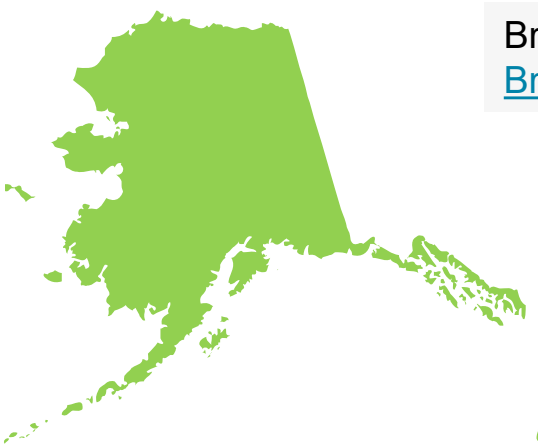
Proctor Communications

- Student can text Proctor through Live Chat at any time if they are having trouble
- Proctor may text student through Live Chat to warn them of rule breaking
- If Live Chat isn't working, Proctor may talk to student through computer
- If connection isn't good, Proctor will call student on mobile phone

Troubleshoot Issues

- Students should do both system test from GED account and system test from VUE during scheduling. If anything isn't fully green, they need to fix their system before test day.
- Plug in laptop
- Have everyone else in house off internet and tell them they can't enter room
- If student can't see themselves in webcam window, they will not be able to test
- If any technical issues occurring on test day or during check in, student should reschedule test to troubleshoot
