



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GED Analytics for New Users Overview



What is GED Analytics?

- A reporting tool used to extract GED-related insights from data providing users with the information they need to make decisions.
- An extension of GED Manager SSO
- Jurisdictional view: State-specific data stats and visualizations with date filtering
- Viewer (Aggregate) vs Explorer (Full) access
- Segments:
 - GED Analytics Summary Reports
 - Additional Reports

Why is it important?

- Access to powerful data visualization metrics
- Identify testing trends
- Target Marketing
 - o 3 of 4 Passers
 - Prep Centers
- Identify high/low performing Prep Centers
- A GED <u>source of truth</u> for decision makers
- Endless possibilities






Access Permission

Jurisdiction-restricted - Access granted by GED Administrator

- Viewer
- Aggregate data only:
 - High level
 - Access to Studentspecific data <u>prohibited</u>
 - Useful for general trend analysis
 - Overall data visualization

- Explorer
- Full Access
 - Candidate Drilldown
 - Test Drilldown
 - Power users
 - Ability to download reports

Sample Situationals I

How can you use GED Analytics to pull this information?



- Case 1: During a board meeting your Director learns that your state's been issued a grant for funding free GED testing. You need to provide data to support her to get the most out of this opportunity.
 - Solutions: Using the Test Taker Summary you can estimate how long the funds will last based on the average number of Test Takers have tested over given period of time.

Additionally...

- Using Test Taker Summary you could identify those marked 'Interested' under Prep Connect Status filter and ask GED to offer a promotional code for first test free.
- Case 2: You want to send a targeted email blast to students who are 1 test away from passing. You decide to run a target marketing campaign from July 1, 2023 thru June 30th, 2024.
 - Solution: You could pull 3 of 4 Passer report from the 'Passed 3 of 4 Modules' tab, giving you a list of emails with just 1 test to go over given date range.





Sample Situationals II

How can you user GED Analytics to pull this information?



- Case 3: Your State Board wants to know how your state compares with other states in their GED scores
 - Solutions: Using 'Additional Reports' select the 'Key Metrics by Jurisdiction' report:
 - o Pass Rate %,
 - #Accounts created
 - # of Tests taken
 - # of Completers
 - # of Passers
- Case 4: The local Adult Educators Association is asking how long the average GED students takes to credential in your state.
 - Solution: From the Test Taker Journey Breakdown report located in Additional Reports, select 'Credential' and download the bar graph displaying that on average it takes X amount of days for a Test Taker to complete their GED credential.
