Background on the 3 of 4 Dilemma

Since we started the current version of the GED test in 2014...

- 142,854 individuals have passed 3 of the 4 required GED tests and never finished the final test
- 81% of these students need to complete Math
- 11% of these students need to complete RLA
- 5% of these students need to complete Social Studies
- 3% of these students need to complete Science
- 33% of these students have selected a GED Prep Center




Background on the 3 of 4 Dilemma

- This issue was a hot topic at our virtual meeting with State Administrators in 2021
- Following that meeting, we created a small working group of states that were planning on running 3 of 4 campaigns so members could share ideas and best practices
- In total, 13 states have conducted targeted campaigns over the past three years
- These types of campaigns have now caught on with individual adult education programs
- Now, dozens of programs across the country have run their own 3 of 4 outreach program



Our Current 3 of 4 States





WE'RE NOT DONE YET 2024 GED CONFERENCE

Who Did We Target?

2021-2024

- Pulled 3 of 4 data from GEDTS
- Years: 2014 2024
- Included all students
- In the most recent campaigns, about 20,500 individuals (6500-7000 each campaign) were identified and contacted in Oct. Jan and May.

2022-2024

- Pulled 2 of 4 data from GED Analytics report
- Years: 2014-2024
- In the most recent 2 of 4 campaigns, about 17,000 individuals (5500-6000 each campaign) were identified and contacted in Oct. Jan. & May.



Administrative Decisions



- Statewide brand for Adult Education is "It's GO Time", so came up with "One to GO" and "Two to GO" for our campaign
- State office wanted to conduct regular outreach using existing MailChimp account
- Initial costs were staff time to implement, since our institution already used MailChimp
- Based on the first year, decided to expand efforts and add in Two to GO during second year



Implementation of Campaign

2021-2023

- State office sent four MailChimp email blasts throughout the year (excluded corrections)
- Provided 2,000 contacts to local programs
 - Combination of phone and email
 - Frequency varied from one time to multiple efforts
- Provided 1,500 contacts to corrections for follow-up



- State office has sent two MailChimp email blasts for each campaign in October, January, May
- Provided about 2,800 One to GO and 2,000 Two to GO prospects to local programs (for each campaign)
- Provided about 4,000 contacts to corrections for follow-up (for each campaign)

Outcomes/Data – 2023-2024

- One to GO and Two to GO emails had a 34% open rate
- As of June 30, 2024: (3 campaigns this year)
 - -One to GO:
 - 1,261 have come in to take at least one test (9%)
 - 599 have tested and passed (4% original list; 48% of those who tested)
 - -Two to GO:
 - 1254 have come in to take at least one test (9%)
 - 407 have tested and passed (3% of original list; 32% of those who tested)



Overall Outcomes/Data

• Since Georgia began this work...2021-2024

2,081 individuals have graduated!



Lessons Learned

- Maintain thorough note-taking and records now that multiple campaigns have launched
- Engage local programs in the effort more

 Developed a report that programs can use to monitor current students
- Establish clear timelines for analysis and generating lists to communicate to the field



Next Steps

- Conduct four rounds of outreach in FY25
 - Targeted outreach to those who tested but did not pass
 - Targeted outreach to graduates who have not enrolled in postsecondary
- New HOPE HSE Examination Grant to cover test fees
- Identify One to GO/Two to GO graduates for feature stories to encourage others
- Develop Two to GO logo and collateral
- Potentially utilize TargetX, a new customer relationship management tool, to engage prospects

March Madness, formerly One Shot/Super Saturday Weekends!

Focus on currently enrolled STUDENTS - sign up in class with their teachers (Subject of CHOICE)

Usually <u>once per quarter</u>, **Friday night from 6:00pm until 9:00pm to attend a "crash course"** in the subject area of their choosing.

Return on Saturday morning at 9:00am AND take the **GED Ready® test** for that subject, if they score at least a **154 on the Ready test**, then they will <u>receive a voucher</u> to take the official test on that same day.

Students are also able to pay for the official test and take it on the same day if they do not meet our cut score (approx. 65%), if they so choose.

Those who do not make the cut score, choose to pay the costs for the test(s) – approx. 10%

THREE TESTS AWAY!

Phone calls/emails sent two weeks prior to scheduled boot camp.

Interested callers from the campaign were given the in one or more subjects. GED Ready[®] Tests! TABE tests!

Boot Camps w/certified content teachers for two/three weeks. Students attended in-person and/or virtually.






JCAE Fast Facts

~1500 students annually *900+ ESL *~600 ABE/GED

Diverse: 70+ countries, 30+ languages, ages 16-70+





Morning, afternoon & evening classes 67 fall classes; 65 spring 47 part-time/3 full-time instructors

GED 3 of 4 success plan

- 1) Received list from KBOR High School Equivalency state manager
- 2) Investigated names on the list
 - 1) Program students
 - 2) Currently enrolled
 - 3) Which test was remaining
- 3) Contacted former students NOT currently enrolled and provided them with information to return
 - 1) Email
 - 2) Phone call
- 4) Identified Math was most of the student's last test
- 5) Wrote a Dollar General Grant to host a Math Bootcamp over the summer to help get students to return and finish their test.



GED 3 of 4 success plan

3 of 4 list:

101 people listed as having only 1 test left
75 had attended JCAE
20/75 current JCAE students
16/20 current JCAE were working on their final test-Math
44 were not attending and had Math as their final test



GED 3 of 4 success plan

Results:

20/75 current JCAE students-all completed
16/20 current JCAE were working on their final test-Math
44 were not attending and had Math as their final test
Wrote a Dollar General Grant to create a Summer Math Bootcamp



Summer Math Boot Camp

Summer Math Boot Camp:

6 weeks

Focused on:

- 1) Math Anxiety
 - JCCC Counselor came in and presented on math and testing anxiety and provided students with the strategies over the six weeks to help support them through the anxious thoughts
- 2) Math Skills
 - 1) Mix of whole group and individualized learning to help the students learn the skills to successfully complete their Math GED exam.

Results:

11 students attended, 3 graduated, 6 re-enrolled in the Fall semester and 3/6 completed





Continued follow-up

Twice a year we email and call students still on the 3 of 4 list to come and re-enroll with us. We no longer are tracking off of that list, but we continue to contact.






GED Analytics Can Run a 3 of 4 Report for Your State

Tips for Adult Education Program Outreach



Adult Education Outreach

Option 1: Reach out to your state GED Administrator, request that they run a 3 of 4 passers report from GED Analytics

- They can run a specific 3 of 4 passers report for your program for as far back as 2017
- They can also now run a 2 of 4 passers report

Option 2: For GED Manager users, you can run reports from the Student Test Activity Page in GED Manager

 This data will be a little broader and might require a little more work but it can generate a target list



Filter in the Student Test Activity Report

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- Set your date range (I recommend going back at least 4-5 years)
- Under "Testing Activity," select GED Passed
- Under "Credential Status," select Not Credentialed

This will pull students who have passed GED tests who never credentialed.



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Once you have run the report, sort by Name

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- Click the Name filter
- This will sort alphabetically by name and show you how many and which tests a student has passed
- You can export this data into Excel



Adult Educator Outreach

- Try to keep email outreach brief and to the point
- Don't be afraid to call or text students
- Consider offering incentives to students to come back to your program (e.g. free GED Ready test, free test voucher, waive adult education program fee, etc.)
- Consider a regular schedule for student outreach (e.g. email campaign two weeks before each semester)

National Numbers

- 14 states conducted 3 of 4 campaigns that targeted 60,888 students and 5,382 students finished their last GED test based on this outreach!
- <u>5,509 lives</u> that are now forever changed thanks to state outreach!
