The National Situation

- Availability of in-person GED[®]/HSE testing severely limited during the pandemic due to stay at home orders, etc.
- Re-opening status of in-person testing varies greatly from state to state and even areas within some states
- These are the busiest months for GED testing and many thousands of individuals have been without a good option to test
- Many individuals are likely wary of an in-person testing due to health concerns, even when it is available

Online Proctored (OP) GED® Test Pilot – The Basics

- Test-takers can take the GED test from the comfort of their home or other location that meets the criteria
- Why? To create a pressure relief valve and provide more access to those ready to test and move on with the next steps in their life
- What is it? The GED test is delivered online and is continually monitored by a trained proctor and A.I.
- Who is administering the test? GED Testing Service is contracting with OnVUE to deliver the Online Proctored GED exams.
- **We are not moving away from the traditional in-person test center model.**

Online Proctored Testing Considerations

We are using a pilot approach because:

- Of timeliness - intense pressure to have an option available as soon as possible.
- There are certain aspects we don't have available yet, but will have available in the next 1-2 months
- Security of the test is always a concern and especially so with a brand new delivery method
- We are just beginning to understand the appetite for participation & how students will react to O.P.
- The OP GED Test Pilot started in late May & we have expanded access as quickly as possible. More than 1,500 individuals to date have taken an OP GED test nationally, with hundreds becoming GED grads

Taking an OP GED Test: How it Works

- Students register and schedule their OP test via their ged.com account
- Students must earn a score of 145 or higher on the GED Ready test within the past 60 days in any subject area(s) they wish to take via OP
- Requires a laptop or computer with a camera/microphone and stable internet connection.
- Must be in an enclosed room with a door than can be shut, quiet environment, no other individuals in the room
- Appointments are available 24/7
- OP test scores will be available within a couple of hours after testing if not sooner
- Students must complete a system check at the time of their appointment to ensure their system will support delivery of an OP exam.

What Students Will Be Eligible: Policy Highlights

- Must be 18 year or older to take an OP GED test
- Must score 145 or higher on the GED Ready test within the past 60 days in the subject area(s) you wish to take via OP – GED Ready is 50% off per subject until July 15th
- OP GED test is available in English during the pilot. A Spanish version will come later this summer.
- Test accommodations aren't available during the pilot
- Requires a laptop or computer with a camera/microphone and stable internet connection.
- Must be in an enclosed room with a door than can be shut, quiet environment, no other individuals in the room

Policy Highlights Continued

Students will not be allowed to retake exams on O.P. during the pilot phase

- Retakes, after taking an O.P. test, must be done in a physical T.C.
- Students cannot retake exams on O.P. if they have passed that test subject, or if they have previously earned a GED credential/diploma.

Students may cancel or reschedule, with a full refund of test fees up until 30 minutes before their scheduled testing time.

- Cancellations can be done via their GED.com account or by calling the Call Center

No-shows. Students who do not start their exam check-in/exam within the 15 minute grace period after their appointment time will be deemed a no-show and will forfeit any exam fees.

Policy Highlights – Check-in ID Requirements

Students, when checking in, must provide a picture (captured at the time of check-in), a picture of their photo ID, and pictures of their workspace used for testing

- IDs must be government issued. We are allowing expired IDs due to the pandemic
- They must include name, DOB, signature and photograph
- Primary forms of ID accepted include:
 - Passport
 - Driver's license
 - Learner's permit
 - National/State/Country identification card

Policy Highlights – Calculator, White Board, Unscheduled Breaks

- Only the on-screen calculator may be used with O.P. tests
 - Handheld calculators are not allowed for security purposes
 - The on-screen calculator is the same as that on GED Ready, and on the computer-based testing tutorial (link provided on resource slides)
- Only the on-screen “scratch pad” can be used with O.P. tests
 - Students cannot use physical scratch paper or dry erase boards
- Students may not take unscheduled breaks during the exam
 - Doing so will result in test invalidation
 - Scheduled breaks, as outlined in GED testing policies, continue to be allowed




OnVUE Onscreen Whiteboard – About Page – Coming Late July

Onscreen Whiteboard

- You will have access to an onscreen whiteboard so you can use your mouse to draw and write out math calculations. Access this feature anytime during your test by clicking the Whiteboard icon at the top of the screen.
- You can open and close the whiteboard and your notes will not be lost. The close button is the "x" icon located above the "Pen" tool in the top-left of the Whiteboard.
- Use the "Pen" tool to draw and write out your math problems
- Use the "Eraser" tool to erase parts of your work
- Use the left and right arrows to "undo" and "redo"
- The "Clear" button in the bottom left corner is used to erase the entire whiteboard and all your notes

- Make your students aware of the OP testing option
- Educators can help ensure students who need OP testing be prepared by having a GED Ready score of 145 or higher
- Making students aware of OP test resources
- We **highly recommend** students run a system check prior to scheduling an OP test appointment
- GED test vouchers that were utilized for in-person testing will work for payment with an OP test as well

OP GED Test After the Initial Pilot Phase

- We will have a Spanish version (August)
- Additional testing accommodations will be available (late July or August)
- We expect we will have a process for 16 & 17 years olds to test via OP (late July or August)
 - **Policies and eligibility will vary by state*
- Each state will let us know what role they want OP GED testing to have after this initial pilot phase







About Online GED Testing

Take your GED test from the comfort of your home, while securely monitored by an online proctor.



What's Needed to Test Online



Computer, Webcam, Internet

You need a computer with webcam and reliable internet.



Private Workspace

The room should have four walls, a closed door and no distractions.



Be 18+ Years Old

You must be at least 18 years old and have a government-issued ID.



'Green' GED Ready Score

You must take a GED Ready practice test and score 'green' within the last 60 days for each subject in which you want to test online.

How It Works

- 1 Perform a **system test** to make sure your computer, webcam and internet connection meet the requirements for testing online.
- 2 Schedule your online test within 60 days of scoring 'green' on a GED Ready practice test.
- 3 Log in to GED.com 30 minutes before your test appointment to launch your test.
- 4 Follow the on-screen steps to check-in for your test including verifying your system, I.D. and workspace.
- 5 Take your test while an online proctor monitors you just like they do at a test center.

Before Test Day

Run a System Test

It's important to do a system test on your computer **before** test day to make sure your computer meets the [minimum requirements](#) for online testing. If you wait until the time of your exam to do the system test and something goes wrong, you won't be able to test and will lose your payment.

To do the system test, you will:

- Download and install the OnVUE software
- Follow each step to check your microphone, webcam and internet speed
- Take photos of yourself, your [government-issued ID](#) and your workspace using your webcam or mobile phone

[RUN SYSTEM TEST](#)

Prepare Your Workspace

You will be required to follow these rules for your workspace. If your workspace does not pass a room scan by the online proctor who is monitoring your test, you will not be able to proceed with the exam.

Here's how to prepare your workspace:

- Ensure the room has four walls, a closed door and no distractions
- Make sure no one comes into the room during the test
- Clear everything off your desk
- Turn off and unplug any additional monitors, projectors and televisions
- Place all personal items, mobile phones, headphones and watches out of reach
- Remove any food and drinks, with the exception of water in a clear glass if you choose

If You Need to Reschedule or Cancel

You can reschedule or cancel your test up to 30 minutes before your appointment time by logging in to your GED.com account. You will not be able to reschedule or cancel your test after your appointment time and will lose your payment if you are unable to test.

On Test Day

Check-in for Your Test

Check in for your exam 30 minutes ahead of your scheduled appointment time. If you are late to your appointment, you will not be able to reschedule your online exam and you will lose your payment.

Prior to checking in

- Shut down ALL applications on your computer such as email, Facebook, chat, etc.

How to launch your test

- Log in to your GED.com account
- Click "Launch" from the appointment card, which will take you to the OnVUE exam page
- From the OnVUE page, you can click "Begin Exam" as early as 30 minutes before your exam time

Checking in

- After you click "Begin Exam", follow the steps to complete the system test and to take photos of your [government issued I.D.](#) and workspace
- You will then be placed in a queue for the next available proctor to begin your exam

During the Test

Technical Assistance

- Onscreen chat with the proctor will be available, but the proctor will not answer any questions related to exam content
- Make sure you close out all other applications and complete the system test ahead of time. Poor internet connection is one of the most common technical issues during the test.

Onscreen Calculator

- You will not be able to use a physical calculator but will have access to an onscreen calculator during the exam. Practice with the [calculator tutorial](#).

Onscreen Scratch Pad

- You will have access to an onscreen scratch pad to take notes and perform math calculations

Exam Rules

- Cheating is strictly prohibited
- You consent to being videotaped and recorded
- You must be in a private, walled room with a closed door
- No one is permitted in the room for any reason
- You may not leave your work area for any reason
- You cannot use a calculator or scratch paper, take physical notes or talk
- Personal items, mobile phones, headphones and watches must be out of reach
- Food, drinks, smoking and gum are prohibited
- You can only schedule one online test at a time and can only take one online test per subject. Any retakes will need to happen in-person at a test center.

Breaking any of these rules will result in your exam being revoked, loss of payment, and you will be banned from testing in the future.

Computer System Requirements

It's important for you to run a [system test](#) prior to your online test appointment.

Operating System	Windows 10 Windows 8.1 Mac OS 10.13 and above
Firewall	We recommend taking the test on a personal computer. Work computers generally have more restrictions that may prevent successful delivery.
Internet Browser	The newest version of Microsoft Edge, Safari, Chrome and Firefox or Internet Explorer 11.
Internet connection	Reliable and stable connection speed of 3 Mbps down and 2 Mbps up is required.
Webcam	May be internal or external and connected to the computer.
Sound and Microphone	Verify the audio and microphone are not set on mute in Windows. Mac users may need to allow OnVUE within their 'System Preferences: Security & Privacy: Privacy' settings for Microphone, Camera, Automation and Input Monitoring.
Browser Settings	Internet Cookies must be enabled. Any Pop-up blocking settings must be disabled
Device	All tablets are strictly forbidden, unless it has a physical keyboard and also meets the operating system requirements mentioned earlier.
Power	Make sure your computer is plugged into a power source.

Admission Policy

We ask you to arrive at the test center 15 minutes before your scheduled appointment time. This will give you adequate time to complete the necessary sign-in procedures. If you arrive more than 15 minutes late for your appointment you will be unable to test and you will not be reimbursed. You will be required to provide one or more valid forms of identification on the day of the test. The ID must be government-issued and non-expired. It must also include your name, address, date of birth, signature, and photograph. Your jurisdiction may require additional ID, proof of residence, or may have other requirements for testing. Prior to your testing appointment, it's important for you to check your messages dropdown in the upper left hand corner on MyGED™. If you do not present proper ID or required information (per the jurisdiction policies) you will be turned away the day of testing and will lose your test payments. No personal items may be taken into the testing room. This includes, but is not limited to; bags, notes, phones, pagers, watches and wallets. You can, however, bring your own handheld TI-30XS Multiview Scientific Calculator for the Mathematical Reasoning, Science, and Social Studies tests (not allowed for students testing outside the United States). You will need to store the calculator for Part 1 of the Math test but the testing center staff will tell you where to do this and when you can get it for use on Part 2.


