Screenshot of the Scratch Pad Feature – O.P. tests only

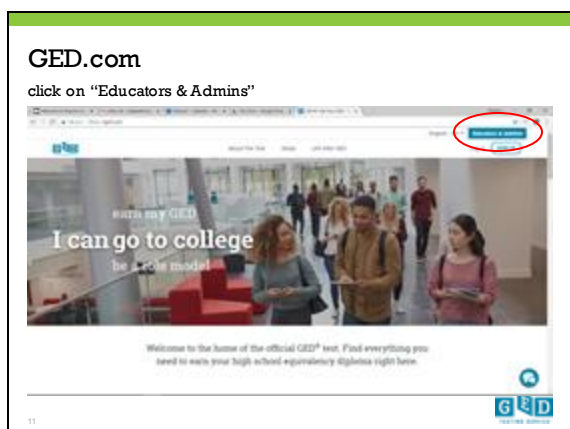


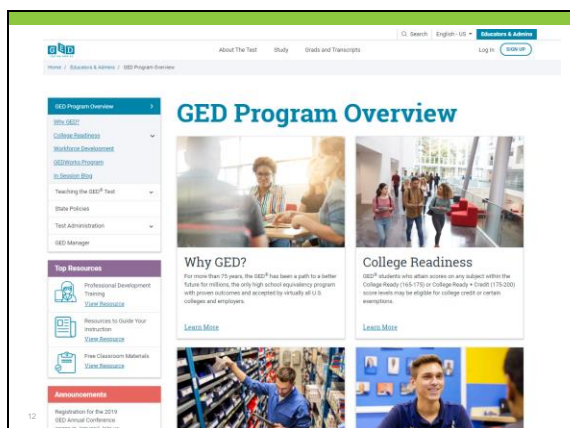

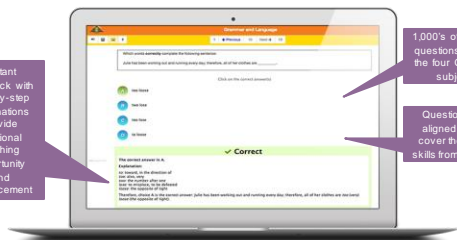
