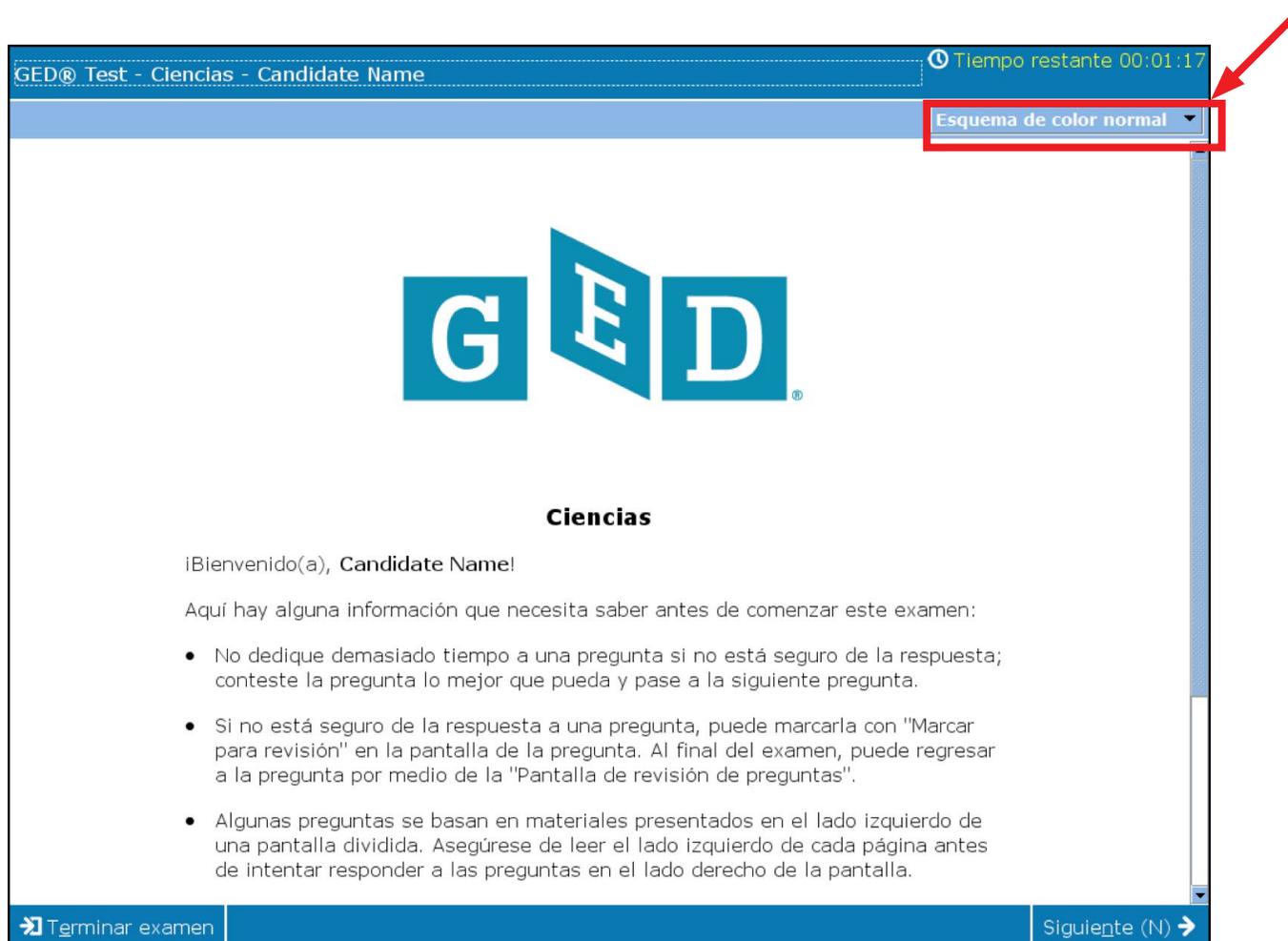

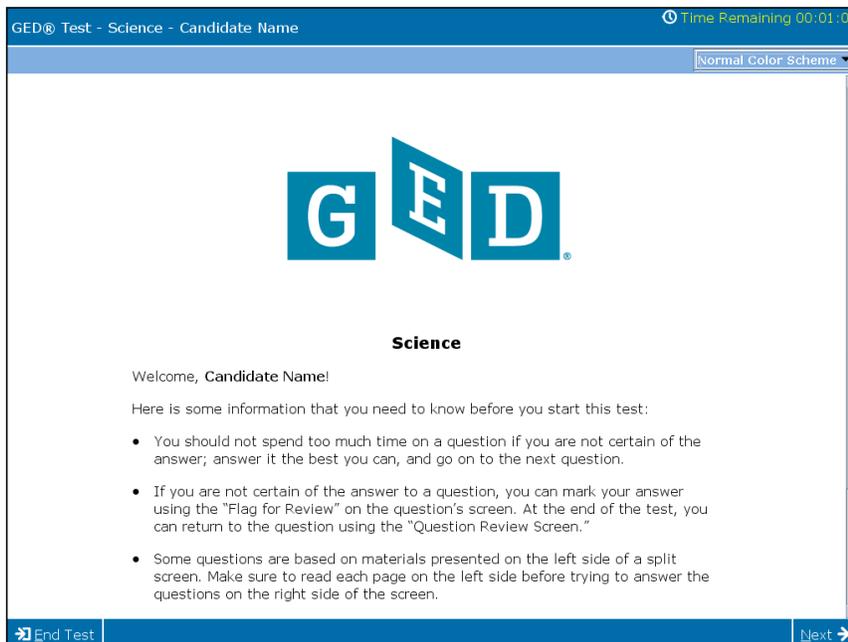
Cambiar los colores del examen es fácil. Simplemente elija los colores del menú desplegable que se muestra a continuación en el recuadro rojo..
